Bacteria: What Products Kill the Most Bacteria?

My question was, out of Bleach, Hydrogen peroxide, Regular Joy brand soap and Antibacterial Joy brand soap, which household cleaning product will kill the most bacteria. My hypothesis was that Bleach would kill the most bacteria, hydrogen peroxide would be the second best killer and the two soaps would kill the same amount. How I tested this was by taking samples of each, spreading them onto a plate, letting them grow for 20-24 hours then count the colonies. My hypothesis was incorrect. I found that Hydrogen peroxide killed the most bacteria, Bleach was the second best killer and Regular Joy brand soap killed more bacteria than Antibacterial Joy brand soap.
