Parking & Maps for 2009 CSEF

FREE OFF-CAMPUS PARKING & SHUTTLE TO CAMPUS

Due to the limited amount of parking on campus and the increased cost of a visitor parking fee, we have arranged for **OFF-CAMPUS PARKING** and a **FREE SHUTTLE** to take people onto campus on **Thursday only**. Parking will be guaranteed at the **CSU Equine Center on Overland Trail** (see attached map), whereas, there is no guarantee of finding a spot on-campus and the shuttle will drop you off at the North end of the Lory Student Center.

To reach the Equine Center from South I-25, take Exit 268 (Prospect Road), West to Overland Trail. Turn North (right) onto Overland Trail to Elizabeth Street. The Equine Center will be to the West (left) immediately after Elizabeth.

To reach the Equine Center from North I-25, take Exit 269 (Mulberry Street/Highway 14), West to Overland Trail. Turn South (left) onto Overland Trail to Elizabeth Street. The Equine Center will be to the West (right) immediately before Elizabeth.

Two shuttle busses (47 passenger) will run between the Equine Center and CSU campus all day on **Thursday from 6:00 AM to 6:30 PM at approximately ½ hour intervals**. When you arrive at the Lory Student Center proceed to the 2nd Floor. Grand Awards Judge's CHECK-IN is located in the Cherokee Park Room in the Northwest Corner of the building (see attached Lory Student Center Upper Level map).

PLEASE ALLOW AT LEAST 30 MINUTES FROM THE TIME YOU PARK IN THE SHUTTLE LOT TO WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT THE CHEROKEE PARK ROOM IN LORY STUDENT CENTER. FOR ALL JUDGES (except Team Captains) PLAN ON ARRIVING AT THE SHUTTLE LOT NO LATER THAN 10 A.M. SHUTTLES WILL BE LEAVING APPROXIMATELY EVERY 20 MINUTES FROM THE CSU EQUINE CENTER.

******* JUDGING TEAM CAPTAINS DO NOT USE THE SHUTTLE *******

For all **non-CSU** faculty or students serving as a Grand Awards Judging Team Captain, you have been provided one **ON-CAMPUS PARKING PASS** since you will need to stay until 8:30 p.m.. **SUGGEST YOU USE THE LIBRARY PARKING LOT** (south of Lory Student Center) or the **Engineering Parking Lot** (north of Lory Student Center).

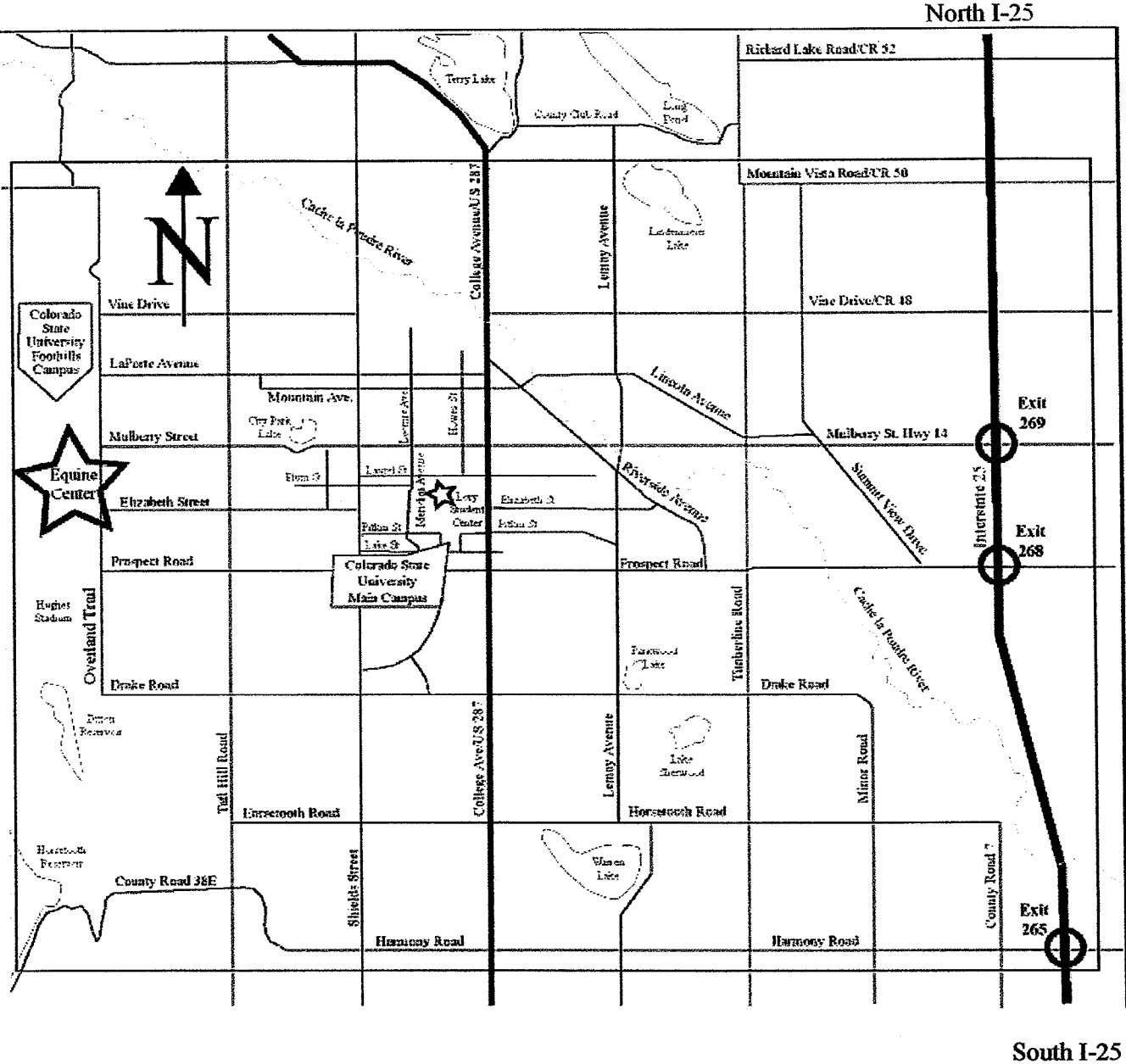
ON-CAMPUS PARKING OPTIONS

For those who want/need to park on campus on Thursday for Judging or who are visiting campus to take part in CSEF activities on Friday, you will be on your own for parking.

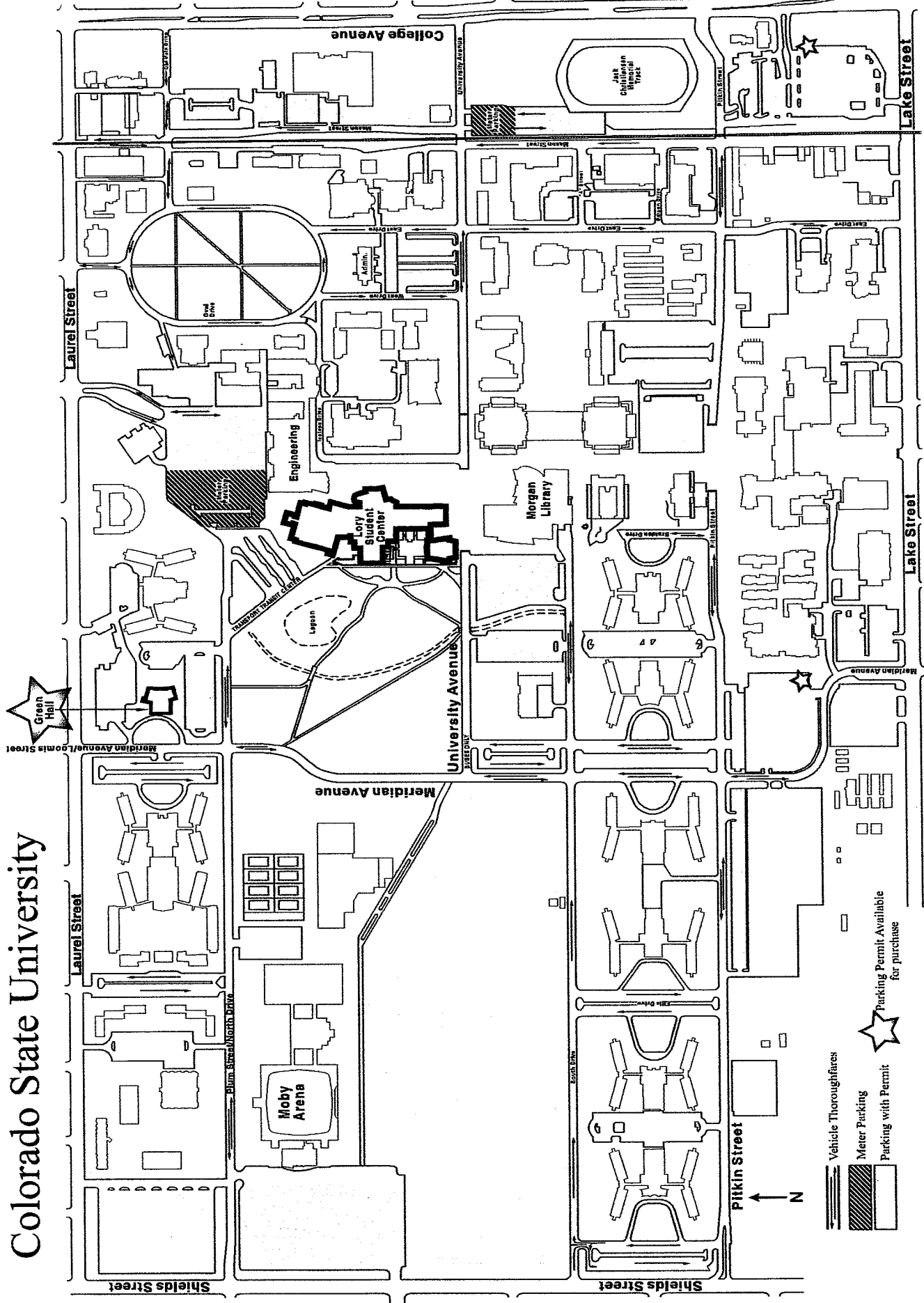
- Parking permits can be bought from Parking Services in Green Hall on the corner of Meridian Avenue and Laurel Street (see attached map) or the University ID/Vending Office in Room 31 of the Lory Student Center. The cost is **\$6.00** for the day. You **MUST** have your vehicle's make, model, year and license plate number when you purchase a permit. There are also parking permit dispensers by the Visitor's Center at the corner of Pitkin Street and College Avenue and by the Visual Arts Building at the corner of Meridian Avenue and Pitkin Street.
- Parking lots that usually have available spots in them are highlighted on the enclosed Campus Map.
- There are several metered parking lots/stalls scattered around campus. Meter Costs are **\$1.00/hour** in all lots. **Please note that although the individual stall meters are no longer present in the Engineering lot, this area is still a metered parking area and payment is made at a centralized kiosk.**
- Vehicles with state or federal plates do not require a parking permit and may park in any of the parking zones (except meters).
- Parking for people with a valid handicapped permit may park in any of the marked handicapped stalls but must have a CSU parking permit, or pay the meters if applicable.
- The Engineering parking lot north of the Lory Student Center fills up fast. Try the lots that are south of the Lory Student Center like the Library lot (#425) and the large "Z" lot (#505) west of the Visual Arts Building.
- **CAR POOL!!!!** If you are driving to Fort Collins each day, try to get together with others from your area.
- **BE AWARE!** Even if you purchase a Parking Permit CSU does not guarantee a parking space.

Parking information and costs provided herein are subject to change by CSU at any time, so please read & follow the instructions on posted signs in the CSU parking lots.
